Race Report: The **SVSC** Turkey Slalom masters race will be on Mar 6th the second half, The Memorial Cup, will be held the next day the 7th **both are at Meadows.** The 6th **is on Stadium and on the 7th Middlefork.** The **Club Championships** are coming up **March 20th.** There are nine classes with the winner of each class getting on the trophy. We run a GS course and classes A & B are scored on a combined two run basis with the rest of the classes using a best of two runs scoring format. The **Snowbird** Race is a part of the Club Championships. The Snowbird is a race to "Encourage those who are discouraged". To qualify for the Snowbird you can't be a "fast racer" (generally A's, B's and some of the C's), a previous Snowbird winner, or a previous class winner over the past ten years. The plan this year is to run the Snowbird as a separate GS type race **after** the Club Championship races. Terry and Ed expect to set a special course for the Snowbird. We will have a **Calcutta** auction at the March 9th meeting for the Snowbird. Eligible racers are placed in betting groups based on our best guess as to who will show up and trying to make each group worth bidding on. Things taken into consideration include past results and likelihood of showing up. There might be one "ringer" in each group, or if there aren't enough ringers, there might be more than one second tier participant in a group to increase chances of getting 2nd and/or 3rd. We have put a couple of ringers in the same group before because they rarely or had never shown up so it behooves the winning betters to bribe them to show up. If someone that fast were regular participants, they wouldn't be included in the Snowbird. Results for the championships and Snowbird will be announced at the **steak fry** at the Welches Lions Club that night. For the steak fry its BYOB cocktail hour at **6:30ish** with dinner at 7ish. \$10 a person for dinner at the door. **PACRAT Racing:** Our team is currently in 12th position. The next one is Mar 14th Meadows-Stadium; Mar 21st Make up race Meadows; Apr 2nd RAT Attack Party (tentative); TBA Summer Sun Attack at Ski Bowl. We are currently in 14th place. MHM **spring passes** are available for \$119 if purchased before Jan 31st. In Feb. the cost will be \$149 thereafter \$179. The spring season is Mar. 1st through Apr. 25th.
