Shotgun Shoot, BBQ and Hwy Clean-up: It's time again for the **SVSC** Trap Shoot & Hwy Cleanup on September 9th, a Saturday. The hwy clean-up will start at 9:30am everyone meet at the Ski Bowl West parking lot, east end (if you are late go to rest area). All associates and newbie's need to attend. The more people we have the faster it will go. When finished everyone is to go to the shotgun shoot for lunch. This year the shotgun shoot will be at the old gravel pit near Trillium Lake (**DO NOT go to the gravel pit that we have used the last few years that is towards Maupin!!**). Take the Trillium Lake exit and follow that all the way to the last left on the paved road, just prior to the turn that takes you to the end of the lake. Don will put up some pie plates/signs. Follow that road until the road takes a sharp left up the hill and to the gravel pit. You can't miss us once you are in the gravel pit. The trap shoot this year will be **\$25**, which includes: 2 Boxes of 12 gauge shells, clay targets and a great BBQ lunch with non-alcoholic drinks provided by Ed Rogers. There will be a safety speech prior to anyone shooting and NO alcohol beverages or other intoxicants before or while you are shooting. There will be as usual the 3 gun Annie, so bring dollar bills. There may be a few extra shotguns if you don't have one, but **PLEASE** try to bring your own. Be aware 12 gauge shells are all that are being supplied. Extra boxes will be \$7 a box; pay Don Clay. This is a very fun event. If you have never shot before that's OK there will be people, including Don, that can help you. You don't have to sign up just show up.
