Ed and crew set a great course with 27 gates – a dual course panel slalom. The snow was pretty firm and mostly held up for four runs (two races) with a few ruts forming toward the end of the races. And the weather was good all day. Thanks to Susan Mills who was our starter, Sheri Parshall who (wo)manned the finish shack/timer, and Adam Miller with various duties in the finish area. Jesse Scroggins showed up to defend his title with Peter Dodd and Ed Rogers making him work for it. The three of them traded fastest runs over the four run day and given Jesse's advanced age and our handicap system for the series (1/2% handicap for each year over 21 and an addition 1/2% for each year over 70), Jesse takes the lead for the 2022 Terry Walter Condor Cup.
