**Terry Walter Condor Cup:** We have completed the two first Terry Walter Condor Cup race days, one at Ski Bowl and one at Meadows. We have had great turnout with 29 of the boys at both races, six of our Skiyente friends at Ski Bowl and eleven at Meadows. Speedy Petey was fastest at Ski Bowl and Adam Miller was fastest at Meadows but, given his advanced age, Ed Rogers is leading the standings based on age handicap. Our last Terry Walter Condor Cup race day will be March 30 at Timberline. Look for more details the week before.

**The Club Championships – Snow Bird:** March 23<sup>rd</sup> at Meadows (please note the prior Buzzard incorrectly said Ski Bowl) followed by some “light” BBQ at Ed's garage and then the annual awards dinner at the Welches Lion's Club, \$20 at the door for a nice steak dinner. Doors open at 6PM, food is served about 7. BYOB. We are hoping to be on Middlefork. Watch for emails this week with more details on race venue, waivers, and lift tickets. The race will start at 10AM. Depending on which run we are on it could be a dual course or single course, race with guys in your class. Slowest class

goes first. Reverse order within class for second run. Both runs count for classes A, B and C. Best of two runs for remaining classes.

A single course "open" GS will be set after the main race for the Snow Bird. Snow Bird participants should preview the course as it is set and get back to the top ASAP. Oldest to youngest, one run race. Come out and have some fun and try to get your name on the trophy. Watch for Class and Snow Bird lists with this and prior emails – let Dale know if any questions. Please note that "snow sport specific" helmets are required for SVSC racing.
