With December's arrival we are still waiting for measurable snow on Mount Hood, all areas having postponed their openings. While we are in a mild La Niña the warm November temps keep the moisture in the air turning into the white stuff we need. Mid November snow levels at Timberline were 24" below the historical average and even though we have finally started building a bit of a base, we are well behind the average of 42" the resort usually has on December 1.

With cold air finally in the mix NOAA is forecasting snow, but as temps rose at elevation what had been forecasted as snow is coming down as rain. Fingers crossed, resorts will have their chairs spinning mid to end of the month. If you are desperate, and willing to drive a bit, Silver Mountain has one lift running with 2 out of 81 trails open and
